Challenger Sports began running summer soccer camps since 1985, as British Soccer Camps, a division of All American Indoor Sports Inc. The <u>British Soccer</u> Camp program quickly grew throughout the Midwest, expanding into Oklahoma, Tennessee and Georgia, and establishing a reputation of delivering quality coaching with a unique British cultural twist

Challenger built a quality staff of full-time Regional Soccer Directors and within two years had established a network of offices throughout the United States and then branched into Canada in 2004. Challenger also invested heavily in the United Kingdom and were the first North American-based soccer company to set up a full-time recruitment and training operation in Britain.

Challenger now runs over 2,000 British Soccer Camps for 100,000 children and also coaches a further 50,000 players on their rapidly expanding year round <u>Club Trainer programs</u>.

The Challenger Club Trainer program was created in 2001 to allow youth soccer clubs to experience the same level of training they receive during their camps to be extended into their actual soccer season.

The high demand for professional soccer training has allowed the Club trainer program to grown in a similar vest to the Challenger soccer camps. Challenger Sports currently has over 150 trainers nationwide in the US and that success is down to the high level of commitment our staff show and the level of professionalism that we bring to the field.
